

## Rome-Based Private Bank Hires Ex-JPM Monti as Head of Banking

(Bloomberg) -- Rome-based Banca del Fucino hired Enrico Monti, previously a director at JPMorgan Chase in London, as head of Banking, Markets and Real Estate Finance, he said in a phone interview.

- Monti will help to connect private equity and private credit firms to Italian SMEs and Mid-Caps looking to grow: interview
- Monti will look at small and mid-sized “companies that are aiming to become a target for an eventual acquisition or IPO”
- One of the priorities will also be to support and define the strategic growth plan for the Fucino green unit to unlock its value
- Monti is also working in potential deals with football clubs in Italy’s Serie A
  - He sees big potential to modernize clubs and improve capital structures to find investors
  - During his time at JPM, Monti was involved in sports financing deals including the acquisition of ACF Fiorentina, AS Roma and AC Milan in Italy by US investors, as well as financing related to the acquisition of Chelsea by a consortium led by Todd Boehly
